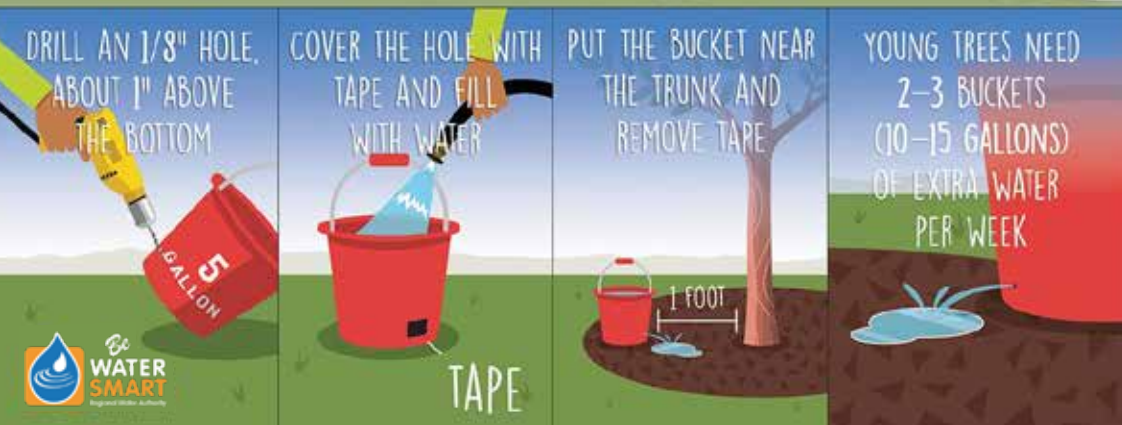
ARE YOU WASTING WATER DOING THIS?
