ELECTIONS UPDATE

Last November, San Juan Water District held our last at-large election. Five candidates from Placer and Sacramento counties vied for the two at-large positions. ACWA Vice President Pam Tobin and long-time Board member Ken Miller were re-elected to serve the 2020-24 term. Director Tobin has served on the Board since 2004 and Director Miller since 1976, with a seven-year hiatus from 1985 to 1992.

PRELIMINARY WATER SUPPLY CONDITIONS

As of mid-February, this winter has been fairly dry. Storage levels may be lower than normal this year in Folsom Reservoir, but we don't expect to see the extreme conditions of 2015. We do not foresee any emergency actions that customers need to take this year to respond to a drought, but water allocations by the Bureau of Reclamation will not be final until April or early May. San Juan will provide an update in our May/June WaterGram and be sure to visit what's new at sjwd.org to get an update on water supply conditions. Regardless of the water supply conditions, we always ask our customers to use water efficiently and not waste it.
